Dear Prayer Partners and Ministry Supporters,

Each year holds something different for us. Last year (2009), we saw the outworking of something the Lord had done inside our hearts in 2008. We really wanted to touch people's hearts the way Jesus did and see more significant results when we ministered.

We were not content with high numerical results. We are happy with them, but not content. We wanted to see God do a deeper work. That kind of work requires more than what we can offer alone. It requires the work of the Holy Spirit. The last two years, we have been studying and working hard to see the Spirit do more through our ministry. The result was that in 2009 we had the most significant results we have ever seen. People were genuinely touched by God in a way we have not seen until now.

In Pikeville, KY, a woman we ministered to had chronic panic attacks and had to take medication. For three nights, we ministered and pray for her. On the fourth night she reported to us, "I started to have a panic attack, and then I prayed like you taught me. By the time I finished praying, the attack was gone!" This was the first time she was able to get control over them.

There were many other stories of people being touched by God in special ways, not just spiritually, but physically as well. A pastor of a church where we were ministering had laryngitis. We prayed for him during the service. The next night, he stood before the church and said, "My laryngitis is completely gone!"

God is doing a new work in us and a classic work in the world saving souls and touching people's lives.

MINISTRY IN BRIEF

TEACHING AT RETIREMENT COMMUNITY

Numerous times throughout the year, we were asked to teach at Atherton Place in Marietta, GA. A group of 10-12 gathered to hear the Scriptures taught.

REVIVALS + OTHER PREACHING

We conducted two revivals. One in Pikeville, KY and another in Prattville, AL. We were also invited to minister at Open Door Bible church in Hudson, MI.





TRAINING PASTORS

We were invited to Kansas to train pastors to equip church members in personal evangelism and follow-up. A friend of mine, Clint Decker, was conducting a Crusade (called "Wheatland LifeFest") in that city, and he asked me to train the pastors to teach the counselor training course. On Friday (June 19), I spoke at a pastor's breakfast designed to raise awareness for training opportunities. Then in the evening on Friday and all day Saturday, I trained 4 local pastors to teach the Christian Life and Witness Course in their city.



CRISIS CHAPLAIN DEPLOYMENT

We were trained in Crisis Chaplaincy by the Billy Graham association, and when the flood struck our city in Woodstock, GA, it was natural that we would be deployed. We prayed for 80+ people, shared the Gospel 20+ times, and were friends to many people as they dealt with their loss.



INNOVATIVE EVANGELISM CONFERENCE

To cap off a very productive year, we attended an Innovative Evangelism Conference in Portland, OR. It was hosted by Luis Palau and the Next Generation Alliance for evangelists. Besides meeting some new awesome people and reconnecting with great friends, I was able to meet with French evangelists.

We have been in contact with these French evangelists through email for a couple months, and this was my first time to meet them personally. It is so wonderful the instant connection Christians can enjoy! I really feel that we made some life-long friends and partners in the Gospel.
